TRAVELING TO CAMP ARRIVALS

Sunday is the usual travel day coming to camp. We are at the Portland Airport on arrival day from 10:30 AM to 2:00 PM. We recommend that your plane land in Portland around noon. Day Early: Saturday airport pick ups are anytime between 10:30 am and 6:00 pm. Saturday arrivals give your bags additional time if there are hang-ups, allow for flight complications due to thunderstorms and get you an extra day of skiing. The charge for **day early is \$200.**

Do not purchase tickets until you have received your confirmation. Call the camp office at 1-503-337-2230 for instructions regarding time variations.



DEPARTURES

Saturday is the departure day. Schedule your flight home to depart Portland Airport between 10:30AM and 2:00PM. If your plane leaves before 10:30 AM, we will send you to the Airport on a Limo (Airporter). Cost is around \$170.

UNACCOMPANIED MINORS

“Unaccompanied Minors” are those young children deemed by the airlines as too young to travel without an escort . Each airline has their own charges and policies. If you arrive and depart during our normal airport pickup times, things should go smoothly without any extra fees. If we are required to send an adult to accompany someone departing who needs to be checked in and is on a limo, be prepared to pay \$170, plus extra shuttle fees.

LODGING AND MEALS

The Lodges at Salmon River Meadows have a total of 13 bunk rooms in 2 buildings. In addition we have a ski room, wax room, meeting rooms, storage and game room, dining room and kitchen serving the best camp food in the area. Overflow housing is in Government Camp (AKA Govy). On campus, we have basketball hoops, volleyball and clay tennis court, 2 trampolines, lots of rails, ropes course; as well as, the only soccer field on the mountain. Our location is at Wapinitia, 5 miles south-east of Government Camp on US Highway 26. All lodging costs are included in our camp fees.
